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# **ABOUT THIS GUIDE**

Welcome to the Capital Area Resource Navigation Guide for Providers. The purpose of this guide is to help community providers easily identify and connect families with young children (prenatal to school age) to the services and supports that meet their needs and preferences. The content within the Navigation Guide focuses on current high needs within the Capital Area and includes concrete local resources that are often missed in statewide resource tools. We are in hopes that this guide can be used to direct providers and families to the right services at the right time.

#### The Capital Area for Early Childhood Defined




Figure 1: Capital Area Defined

The Capital Area Early Childhood Region (Figure 1) was developed in 2022 through the efforts of the Preschool Development Grant, in partnership with the New Hampshire Department of Education (DOE) and New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS). We acknowledge that our communities, as well as the families and individuals we serve, all have unique strengths and needs that impact the supports they may be seeking. This Resource Navigation Guide for Providers aims to identify relevant services and program for the most pressing concerns and issues among families residing in the Capital Area.

# **ABOUT THIS GUIDE**

#### **How to Use This Navigation Guide**

This Guide starts with a **Family Information Sheet** that serves as a basic data and information gathering form to organize key information about the individual and family. This information will help define which resource(s) are the best fit.

The Guide is formatted into six (6) modules. The first module provides information about **Go To Resources** within the region. The additional five modules were identified based on current needs within the region and are defined as:

- 1. <u>Concrete Supports</u> Food, housing, safety, transportation, financial and legal assistance
- 2. Early Care and Education Child care, school, after school, scholarships
- 3. <u>Early Supports and Services</u> Child development and services for chronic conditions. Family Centered Early Supports and Services (FCESS) serves children birth up to age three who have a developmental delay, an established condition, or are at a substantial risk for a developmental delay.
- 4. <u>Family and Caregiver Supports</u> Education/supports, and child caregiver relationship development
- 5. <u>Holistic Health</u> Health insurance access, family health, prenatal services, crisis services, substance use disorder treatment, and support services

Each module will begin with a decision tree organized by common phrases or concerns raised by individuals and/or families. Providers should utilize the decision tree to find immediate services and directions to the appropriate page number within this Guide for additional resources. Both statewide and regional resources have been captured. Regional resources also include the town(s) served.

The Resource Navigation Guide ends with a listing of <u>Professional Groups</u> within the region that meet to discuss sectors covered within this Guide.

This tool is not intended to be an all-inclusive listing of resources and professional groups. We have identified the leading local and state resources for primary areas of concern within the region to assist providers in efficiently triaging the needs of individuals and families.
